You must be **accepted** into Barry University's Traditional Option BSN program **BEFORE** you can apply to become a Baptist Scholar.



For Sophomores



- After completing an application, your pre-nursing advisor will guide you through the process and make sure you have all the necessary pre-requisite courses.
- Once you complete your pre-requisite courses, and are accepted into the BSN program, a representative from the program will email/mail you a copy of the Baptist BOND application.
- Once your application is submitted, a representative from the Baptist Scholars department will schedule an interview.
- After the interview is completed, you will be notified of your acceptance.
