

Barry University Students

All Barry students residing in campus housing, all international students on an F-1 or J-1 Visa, all Barry Athletes, and students in academic programs that require full insurance coverage (Nursing, Podiatry, Physician Assists, Law, Anesthesia) are automatically enrolled in the Student Health Insurance Plan (SHIP) and must activate their coverage prior to using it.

1. Click the “I want to Enroll” button on your dashboard
2. Select the coverage options you would like to enroll in and then Add to Cart
3. Once you are done with your selections, click “Proceed to Checkout”
4. Select your coverage and the payment option “Charge through School” - **NOTE:** You will not be required to pay at this time. The charge for one semester of insurance has already been billed to your student account.
5. Your insurance is now active for use, and you will receive confirmations to your school email address

Barry students are eligible to waive SHIP if their private insurance meets Barry University's waiver requirements. The deadline to waive for Fall 2026-2027 is **09/18/2026**

To submit a waiver, you must take action no later than 09/18/2026 by completing the online waiver form using these steps:

- 1. Go to students.care26.com and enter your @barry.edu email**
- 2. Click "Log in using my Barry account"**
- 3. After logging in to your Barry University account, you will be taken to the Care26 dashboard**
- 4. Click on "I want to Waive" to confirm you meet the waiver criteria**
- 5. Enter your insurance information and attach your required insurance documents (an electronic copy of the front and back of your current insurance ID card and full policy document), then submit your waiver**

All waivers will be verified to ensure compliance with minimum coverage requirements. If the information provided is incomplete, incorrect, cannot be verified, and/or does not satisfy criteria, the waiver will not be accepted and health insurance coverage through Barry University will be required. If the information provided is approved, the SHIP fees will be removed from the student's account.
